The Technische Universität Dresden (TUD), coordinating institution of the EMCL Erasmus Mundus Course, represented by Prof. Dr.rer.nat.habil. Steffen Hölldobler, and the above mentioned Scholar conclude the present contract under the following terms and conditions:

Conditions

1. The scholarship is being granted to perform teaching, research assignment and student tutoring activities.
2. The Scholar
 - must spend a minimum of two weeks / a maximum of three months at the respective hosting institution (HI),
 - commits him/herself to actively participate in the EMCL Program (e. g. by teaching of specific courses, organizing and directing of seminars/workshops, tutoring students' research/project/thesis activities etc.),
 - contributes after the visit to the promotion and dissemination of the Erasmus Mundus Program in general and the EMCL Program in particular.

The scholarship includes

a living allowance (including travel costs) amounting to 1200 EUR per week for a max. duration of three months.

Minimum: 2400 EUR for a two-weeks stay

Maximum: 14400 for a three-months stay.

Terms

1. The scholarship can only be transferred to a bank account within the European Union. Any charges claimed by the bank must be paid by the Scholar.
2. The payment of monthly installments will start after receipt of a copy of the tickets and the signed contract.

3. The scholarship holder is required to write a report (of about one page) at the end of his/her stay at the HI. It should inform on all EMCL related activities, the local management of the stay, facilities offered at the HI (e. g. housing, cooperation with local staff, positive and negative experiences). The report has to be sent to the EMCL secretary within three weeks after his/her return from the HI.
4. The Scholar confirms that he/she has not carried out his/her main activities for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years in EU-Member States or the candidate countries for accession to the EU. Reference date is: 28 February 2XXX.
5. The TU Dresden may discontinue payments prior to the end of the scholarship if the requirements for awarding the scholarship are severely disregarded.
6. The Scholar is advised to effect an appropriate insurance without of the responsibility of the TU Dresden.
7. The scholarship does not create or entitle an employer-employee relation between TUD and the Scholar, and therefore it is not subject to direct taxation.

The signatories declare that they have read and accept the conditions and terms laid down in the present contract.
